

# DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

**BETWEEN:**

**ASENIA BRUMMET, #84,491**  
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

**College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
also known as **College of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect November 9, 2023. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with the College, ASENIA BRUMMET, #84,491 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College and includes the following:

- The Registrant demonstrated a lack of knowledge, skill, and/or judgment when they failed to follow proper procedure, monitor and assess patients, administer medication(s) appropriately, or provide adequate patient care on one (1) or more occasion.
- The Registrant failed to adequately document their patient care on one (1) or more occasion.

The Registrant agreed to course work on documentation, medication management and introduction to health assessment. The Registrant further agreed to provide two reference letters of indirect supervision for a total of 600 hours of practice. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
