

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

BERNICE CYR, #60,464
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta
also known as **College of Registered Nurses of Alberta**
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect **February 15, 2023**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with the College, BERNICE CYR, #60,464 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- In 2022, the Registrant failed to demonstrate adequate judgment and failed to maintain professional boundaries when they provided patient care in conflict with Alberta Health Services care pathways; and
- In 2022, the Registrant failed to adequately document their interaction with a patient concerning services unapproved by AHS.

The Registrant agreed to complete coursework and pay a fine. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
