



AMENDED DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

BRENDA LYSYSHIN #62,839
(the “**Regulated Member**”)

and

The College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(“**CARNA**”)

An Amended Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**ADCRA**”) was executed between the Regulated Member and CARNA, dated with effect **October 6, 2020**. The below constitutes a summary of such ADCRA:

Through an ADCRA with CARNA, the Regulated Member Brenda Lysyshin, #62,839 (the “**Regulated Member**”) acknowledged and admitted that her behavior constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Regulated Member’s unprofessional conduct arising from one (1) complaint to CARNA includes the following:

- The Regulated Member failed to respond appropriately and promptly to a patient, who was experiencing chest pain. In particular, the Regulated Member failed to respond promptly when requested to assess a patient by an LPN and failed to demonstrate that they understood how to operate BP monitoring equipment.
- Next, the Regulated Member failed to prioritize care for the patient when they failed to promptly contact EMS for transfer to hospital and responded to family requests regarding transfer of another patient rather than referring or delegating such activities to another staff member; attended in another unit to administer medications; continued to administer medications to other patients; and continued with documentation before contacting EMS.
- Finally, the Regulated Member caused unnecessary distress to the patient’s family member when they failed to demonstrate that they were appropriately managing the patient’s health condition.

The Regulated Member agrees to complete coursework on time management, nursing process and the interpersonal aspects of nursing. The Regulated Member’s employer will also provide four (4) Performance Evaluations to the Complaints Director covering a total of 500 hours. Conditions shall appear on the Regulated Member’s practice permit.
