

# **DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT**

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

**BETWEEN:**

**MENG LIN MA, #102,114**  
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

**College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
**also known as College of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect **APRIL 13, 2022**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with the College, Meng Lin Ma, #102,114 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from three (3) complaints to the College and includes the following:

- In 2021 on approximately two (2) occasions, the Registrant failed to effectively communicate and collaborate with other health care professionals about patient care.
- On one occasion in 2022, the Registrant failed to prioritize the care of Patient 1 and failed to effectively collaborate with other members of the health care team when they did not follow up with the physician about Patient 1’s outstanding medication orders. Furthermore, the Registrant failed to uphold medication administration standards when they did not administer medication as ordered by a physician, including magnesium citrate and laxatives. Finally, the Registrant failed to adequately monitor, and document, Patient 1’s urine output while the patient’s condition was deteriorating throughout their shift.

The Registrant agreed to complete coursework, pay a fine and must complete a period of supervision in their practice setting. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
