

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

SARAH WHEELER, #92,840
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta
also known as **College of Registered Nurses of Alberta**
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect **June 13, 2023**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with the College, Sarah Wheeler, #92,840 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- An employer investigation determined that the Registrant failed to follow AHS policies on confidentiality and privacy, when they accessed their own personal health care records and at the request of Employee 1, Employee 2 and Employee 2’s husband accessed their personal health records. The Registrant, then at the request of Employee 2 printed their diagnostic result to show Employee 2’s doctor who was on site, where there was no immediate care relationship.

The Registrant agreed to complete coursework and pay a fine. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
