

# DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

**BETWEEN:**

**JUDY CLARKSON, #42,889**  
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

**College of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect April 28, 2025. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a Agreement with the College, JUDY CLARKSON, 42,889 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College and includes the following:

- On July 23, 2021, the Registrant displayed a lack of knowledge, skill or judgment in the provision of professional services when they:
  - failed to check the calculation of the dosage of a medication order for hydromorphone for the Patient;
  - failed to withhold the dose of hydromorphone when it would likely pose a risk of harm to the Patient;
  - failed to consult the authorized prescriber as soon as reasonably possible to confirm the dose of hydromorphone that would likely pose a risk of harm to the Patient.

The Registrant agreed to complete course work on medication management. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
