

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

CORINNE DUHAMEL, #112,844
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect April 22, 2025. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through an Agreement with the College, CORINNE DUHAMEL, #112,844 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- On or around between April 2023 and November 2023, the Registrant demonstrated a lack of knowledge, skill and judgment, and/or one (1) or more employer policies, when they:
 - Attempted to hang an enteral feed into a PICC line;
 - Failed to adequately administer blood products; and
- On or around between April 2023 and November 2023, the Registrant failed to follow infection prevention and control precautions on one (1) or more occasion, and/or one (1) or more employer policies.
- On or around between April 2023 and November 2023, the Registrant failed to adequately document patient care on one (1) or more occasion, and/or one (1) or more employer policies.

The Registrant agreed to complete course work on responsible nursing, and documentation. The Registrant further agreed to provide employer references under direct supervision for a total of 400 nursing practice hours. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
